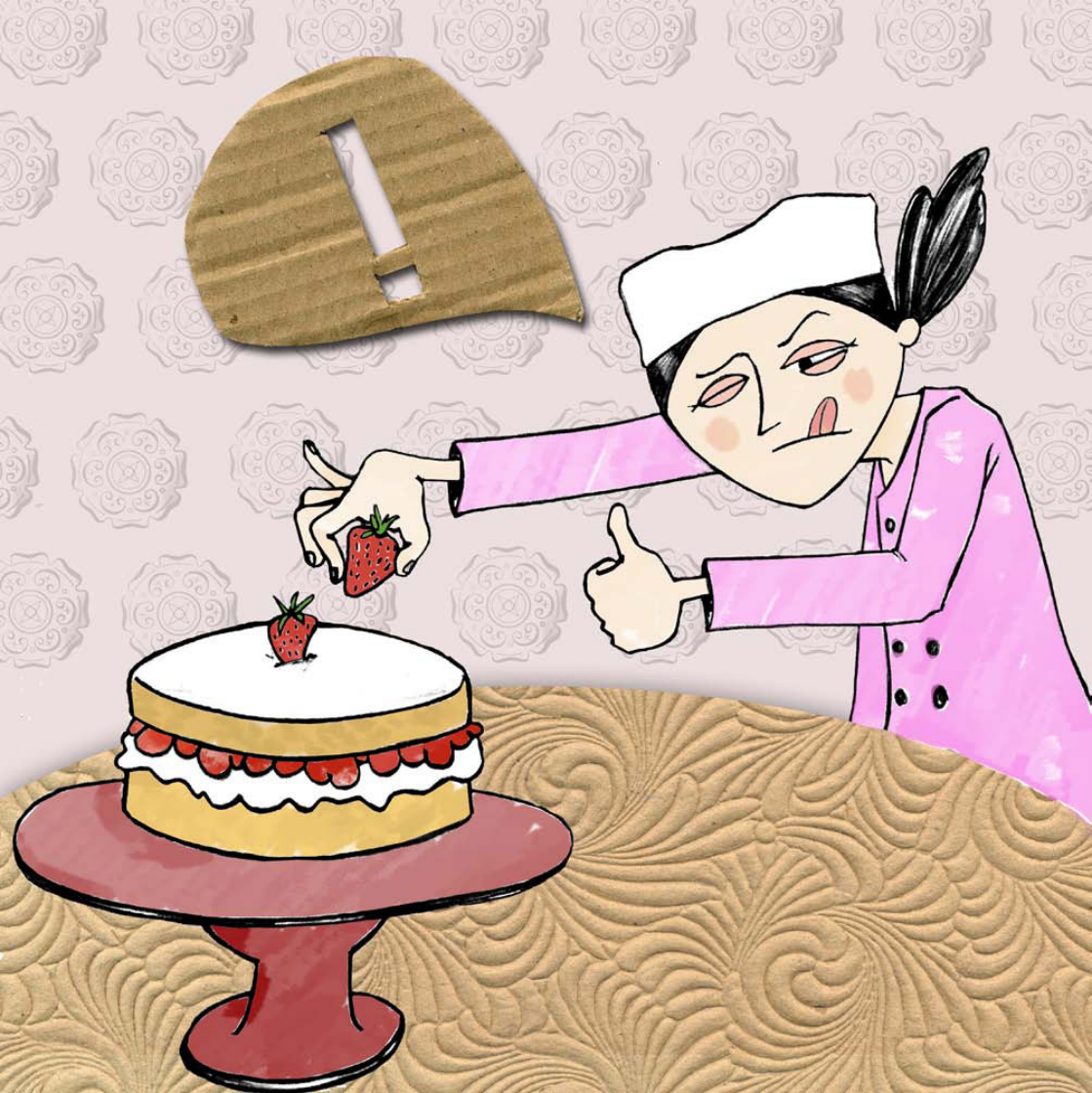
Jane is in the kitchen. She puts on an apron.

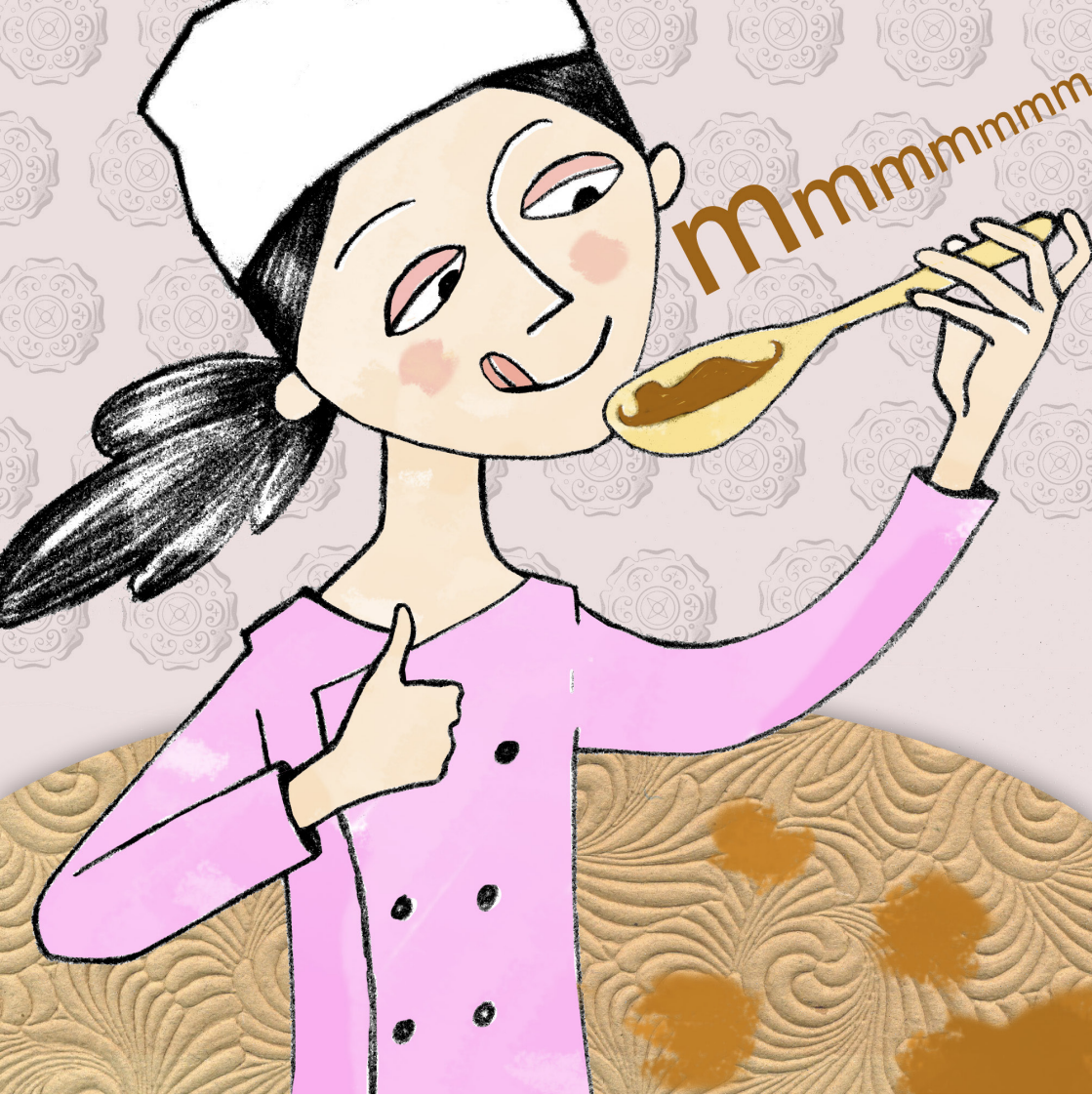
